### **Treasurer's Report:**

- Not too much has changed in the last few weeks. A few merchandise payments were received.

- Most of the shirts and jackets have been paid for and collected.
- Balances
  - \$20.50 in cash, \$1595.87 in the cheque account and \$13363.41 in the savings account. \$14979.78 total.
  - Budget created to facilitate seasons spend. Break even with \$1200.00 in contingency funding (in black). Annual Season dinner to be \$3200.00, similar to same cost last season.

- Match Payment Review

  - John Sherry suggested that we shouldn't cut pay for anyone as we represent all umpires.
  - Match payments are going in front of the WACA board in January which is why the December 31<sup>st</sup> deadline is there.
  - Increases in female cricket payments look excessive compared to everything else.
  - There was feedback from Michael Kovalevs suggesting that some increases could be reduced in order to allow payments not to be cut for anyone.
  - Action Item: All committee members to come up with their own numbers and email to Trent for collation and consensus.
