President's Report



Treasurer's Report

It's been a relatively quiet period on the financial front for the association. We've had a little cash go out for bar tabs and memorabilia to acknowledge some milestones. The money coming in has mainly been for shirts and jackets which are now almost all paid for, and some payments for people attending the life members' breakfast.

At the time of writing we haven't received membership money from the WACA but since the first batch of umpire payments has been paid I'm expecting this will come soon. The expenses we can expect before new year are meeting costs and costs associated with the umpire T20 which is tentatively planned for December 31st.

All in all we are down \$12.91 since the last meeting. The current balances are:

- \$1750.87 in our cheque account
- \$13 363.41 in our savings account
- \$20.50 in cash
- \$15 134.78 total
