• Update from Luke Douglas

- Just been at UAC first meeting. Alan Johanson and Jeff Brookes elected and re-elected respectively onto new committee with Luke, Peter, John and Mick plus person from WADCC to be decided on Monday. Luke and WADCC person are non-voting. Looking at updating terms of reference, ranking policy etc.
- Umpires handbook been sent to committee for feedback.
- Season fixtures hoping to release on Friday. Season structure is the same.
 Some games on Sundays when grounds aren't available on the Saturday
- Season launch Ashlee and Trent invited. Capacity issues with the room so not as many invited as previous years.
- Umpire season launch with the dinner on the 19th.
- Pay rates budgets cut by 25%. \$310K last year budget \$225216 this year.
 - 170k senior men; 38K junior men; 5K junior women; 13K senior women
 - Blanket 25% cut on all rates.
 - Proposal (of 15% cut) to increase the number, some hope that we would get the same rates as last year but this is not likely. Trying to get an extra 50K from the board.
 - Parity would be \$91500 extra needed.
 - Premier cricket and umpire budgets have been cut.
- Ernest asked about membership restructure and how it affects umpires' memberships – Luke sorting out, getting confirmation over coming weeks.
- WACUA committee to meet again next Tuesday to discuss action plan re pay rates.
- John UAC association is required to come up with written criteria for Peter McConnell medal. To discuss at a later date.
